

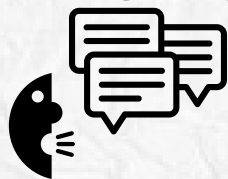
Age 3: the Pal

Parent's job: to develop routines and provide opportunities to play with others

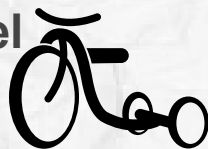
□ **01** More able to follow rules and cooperate

□ **05** May tell tall tales

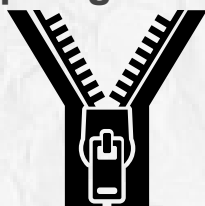
□ **07** Can ride a tricycle or big wheel



□ **09** Asks a lot of questions

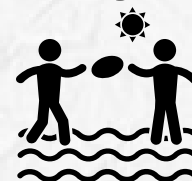


□ **11** Can unzip large zippers
